STATEWIDE ADVISORY 03-2020

Re: COVID-19 (revised per 41 JBE 2020)

On March 25, 2020, the Tax Commission issued Statewide Advisory 02-2020 concerning COVID-19. On April 2, 2020, in further effort to reduce and limit the spread of COVID-19 in Louisiana, Governor John Bel Edwards issued another proclamation which, in part, extended the suspension of all legal deadlines, including but not limited to deadlines contained in Title 47 of Louisiana Revised Statutes on Revenue and Taxation, until April 30, 2020. *See* Proclamation Number 41 JBE 2020.

In compliance with EO JBE 2020-41, all appeal hearings before the Tax Commission remain suspended and continued without date. The Commission will continue to meet telephonically in order to consider change order requests, tax sale cancellations, and similar matters.

Pursuant to La. R.S. 47:2324 and La. Admin. Code 61:V:307(A), personal property renditions must be filed by April 1 of each year; however, this deadline is suspended by EO JBE 2020-41 until at least April 30, 2020. Similarly, pursuant to La. R.S. 47:1852, public service companies must file annual reports by April 1 of each year; however, this deadline is suspended by EO JBE 2020-41 until at least April 30, 2020.
